

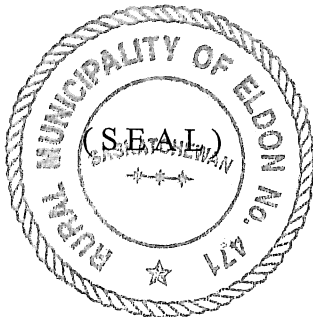


A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 471 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "municipal road" means a public highway or municipally owned roadway that is under the direction, management and control of the municipality;
 - b) "public highway" means a road allowance or a road, street or lane vested in or owned by the province including anything erect on or in connection with the public highway;
 - c) "provincial highway" means a public highway or a proposed public highway under the direction, management and control of the Department of Highways and Transportation; and
 - d) "roadway" means that part of a public highway designed or intended for use by vehicles but does not include a trail designated under *The Snowmobile Act* or any other trail or path for which a permit is required.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 90 kilometers per hour on the municipal roads described as follows:
 - East of Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 & 36-48-24-W3 (Range Rd 3240)
 - North Sections 22, 23, 24-49-23-W3 & North Sections 19, 20, 21-49-22-W3 (Township Rd 494)
 - East Sections 4, 9, 16 & 21-49-22-W3 (Range Rd 3223)
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed of 90 kilometers per hour shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
5. This bylaw comes into effect immediately upon passing.
