

BYLAW -- No. 39

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES ADJOINING ROADS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 471 enacts as follows-----

1. The Council is hereby authorized whenever it deems it to be necessary or expedient to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges as a measure to prevent the blocking of roads by snow drifts during winter months.
2. The person or persons authorized by council to perform the work as herein provided shall have the right of entry on private property for such purpose only.
3. Any person who refuses the right of entry, or who in any way hinders entry upon land for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this bylaw shall be deemed to be guilty of an offence, and liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.

READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 471 at Maidstone in the Province of Saskatchewan this 1st day of December, A.D. 1951.
