

# Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 471

## BYLAW No. 5/2000

### A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW No. 84, THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 471, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Part III, Section 3 of Bylaw No. 84, the Zoning Bylaw is amended by adding the following: “however, this regulation should not apply to a Residential Care Facility” after “Not more than one principal building or use shall be placed on any one site”.
2. Part IV of the Bylaw No. 84, the Zoning Bylaw, is amended by adding the following definition:

Residential Care Facility - means a facility which:

- a) houses not more than 10 residents, provides meals, lodging, supervisory, personal care or individual programming to persons who reside therein for a period of not less than thirty days.
  - b) is duly licensed by the Province of Saskatchewan or certified as approved by the Province of Saskatchewan under an Act which provides for such licencing or certification as the case may be; and
  - c) may include only the principal residence of the operator or administrator; but does not include a prison, reformatory, correctional facility or other facility for the secure and open custody of persons who have been committed thereto by a Court of person having lawful authority under *The Criminal Code (Canada)*.
3. Part VI, Section 1.2.7 of Bylaw No. 84, the Zoning Bylaw is amended by adding the following discretionary use:  
“ 1) Residential Care Facility.”
  4. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Culture and Housing.
