**BYLAW No. 136**

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ELDON. NO. 471  
TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW NO. 84  
KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 471, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. PART VI, Section 2.2.1 is amended by adding the following permitted use:  

“f) motels”
2. PART IV, is amended by adding after the definition for “Mobile Home Court” the following definition:  

“Motel - A building or buildings or part thereof on the same site used to accommodate the traveling public for gain or profit, by supplying sleeping accommodation, with or without meals”.
3. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by the Minister of Municipal Government.
